Nevenka Hrovatin is Professor of Economics at the Faculty of Economics, University of Ljubljana, Slovenia. Since 2001 she has also been acting as Vice-Dean for International Relations. She teaches several economic courses (Microeconomics, Economics of public utilities, Government, regulation and markets, etc). She also taught a Managerial Economics course in an MBA programme delivered by the Faculty of Economics, University of Ljubljana for the Indian Oil Corporation in India. Her research interest is oriented towards public utilities: their liberalisation, regulation, privatisation and pricing policies. She has been participating in several international projects sponsored by the EU. Her research papers were presented at several international conferences and published in international journals and books. She has also been working as a consultant to the Slovenian government, the Slovenian electricity and gas regulator the Energy Agency and several utilities. She is a co-editor of the Economic and Business Review for Central and South-Eastern Europe and a member of the editorial board of the journal Uprava (Administration).

In the past she was President of the Supervisory Board of the Slovenian Securities and Exchange Commission (1994-1998) and President of the Agency of the Republic of Slovenia for Revision of the Ownership Transformation of Companies (2000-2004). In spring 2001 she was Visiting professor at the Glasgow Caledonian University. She was a member of several Supervisory Boards of Slovenian companies (the trading company Metalka and the Slovenian Steel Holding Company SIJ among others) and President of the Supervisory Board of the gas distribution utility Energetika. Currently, she is Vice-President of the Supervisory Board of Energetika.
